### IAQ Council Releases RC Tests on Meth Lab Cleanup

The American Indoor Air Quality Council has published two additional exams to its online testing center, offering certificants another way to earn recertification credits (RCs).

The open book exams cover AIHA's Guideline 8, *Clandestine Methamphetamine Laboratory Assessment and Remediation Guidance* (2007).

"Methamphetamine manufacturing presents a serious indoor air quality problem with which IAQ professionals should be familiar," said Charlie Wiles, IAQ Council executive director. "By encouraging familiarity with Guideline 8, our new RC tests will help our certificants stay abreast of developments in their field."

Certificants can log onto the online testing center 24/7 and take the exams from the convenience of home or office. Each 30 question test is worth 4 RCs.

The IAQ Council's online testing center offers RC exams on a variety of industry texts that certificants may already have, including:
